- In a significant ruling, the Supreme Court has expanded the scope of Articles 14 and 21 to include the “right against the adverse effects of climate change”.
- Linking the right against climate change to Articles 21 and 14, Chief Justice of India DY Chandrachud said the rights to life and equality cannot be fully realized without a clean, stable environment.
- The right to health (which is a part of the right to life under Article 21) is impacted due to factors such as air pollution, shifts in vector-borne diseases, rising temperatures, droughts, shortages in food supplies due to crop failure, storms, and flooding.

- The recent excavation of Harappan site of Rakhigarhi by Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) has revealed the structure of some houses, lanes and drainage system. The ASI excavations also revealed pieces of copper and gold jewellery, terracotta toys, besides thousands of earthen pots and seals.
- The significance of Rakhigarhi is the maturity of the Harappan findings, pre-dating it by almost 1,500 years.
