- ☑ India will acquire MQ-9B Predator drones (Unmanned Aerial Vehicle) from the US, deploying them in Tamil Nadu and Uttar Pradesh.
- Developed by General Atomics Aeronautical Systems, it's a highaltitude, long-endurance armed UAV.
- ✓ Used by the US for surveillance and airstrikes, it has two variants: SkyGuardian and SeaGuardian. The latter has been utilized by the Indian Navy since 2020.

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
