- ✓ Humans get West Nile Fever from the bite of an infected mosquito. The virus may be transmitted through contact with other infected animals, their blood, or other tissues. To date, no human-to-human transmission of WNV through casual contact has been documented.
- ✓ Usually, the West Nile virus causes no symptoms or only mild, flu-like symptoms. The virus can cause life-limiting illnesses, such as encephalitis, meningitis, or meningoencephalitis. There is no vaccine available to prevent West Nile Virus (WNV). So it's important to prevent mosquito bites.
