- It is equipped with a 5,000 or 10,000 mAh battery pack, which can be used as power backup.**
- This type of charger uses the magnetic current present in the mobile phone and the magnets on the MagSafe charger.**
- A good MagSafe charger is just like any other wireless power bank that connects to the mobile phone and works as a power bank.**

- ✓ It was established on the basis of the recommendations of the Nachiket Mor Committee. It is registered as a public limited company under the Companies Act 2013 and licensed under Section 22 of the Banking Regulation Act 1949.
- ✓ It can accommodate deposits up to Rs 2,00,000, and can accept demand deposits in the form of savings and current accounts.
